Emerging Issues and Trends - Su Min Oh/Patrick Hindman/Group

Opioids and Prescription Drugs, Alcohol, Heroin, Marijuana, E-Cigarettes - Su Min Oh/Group

- **Prescription Drugs**
 - PA 246 effective June 1, 2018 (physicians are required to disclose of opioid information to minors and patients).
 - PA 251 effective July 1, 2018 for prescribers treating for acute pain. Will not prescribe within a 7-day period.
 - PA 248 and 281 – Major changes related to prescription drugs.
- **Heroin – N/A**
- **Legalizing Marijuana** – Information will be shared regarding LARA on Cannabis Oil; what's legal and what's not. Joel says ballot proposal has moved forward for marijuana.
- **E-Cigarettes** – House introduced nine bills - no movement. Mention of a first death related to e-cigarettes that occurred in Florida.
- **Alcohol** – Patrick said there is a Ban on Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) infused beer and alcohol. Will send publications to everyone.
- **Advocacy - Unite to Face Addiction Michigan Rally** – Thursday, May 17, 2018; 10:00 am to 4:00 pm., at the Capital. **Administrative Rules** – Angie states the administrative rules are being revised. Third meeting taking place today; encourages everyone to express concerns. The Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) Department is considering eliminating licensing, as well as others. Partner Updates – All

- **Office of Highway Safety Planning (OHSP) – Dianne Perukel**

OHSP Released the 2017 crash data and news release. Alcohol involved fatalities have increased by 32%; county level analysis is not out yet and should roll out in the next couple of months. Drug induced fatalities only increased 4%. Motorcycle and teen fatalities have decreased. Will share with this group. Based on research, we are finding that traffic fatalities have something to do with gas prices and the economy overall.
- **Bureau of Epidemiology and Population Health/Division of Communicable Disease/HAI, Infectious Diseases Update - Joe Coyle**
 - **Syringe Service Programs** – Two jurisdictions have reached out to us to get data to advocate for syringe services programs and how to expand their programs and set up shop. Expansion requests are coming in from various counties; Muskegon to Muskegon Heights; Ottawa and Lake County to begin looking into operations; Northwest District Health Department has received authorization to begin a program in Petoskey. Pam Lynch from Harm Reduction Michigan will be conducting a presentation in Traverse City on Monday. Lisa communicated that a verbal confirmation has been received from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) that we can use the Block Grant (BG) to support Syringe Service programs (staffing and other services); needles cannot be purchased. In the process of revising the BG application.
 - **Other – Opioid Strategic Plan** – The Public Health Administration is interested in developing a strategic plan around opioids, focusing on the three pillars of treatment and prevention; education and surveillance with specific goals and objectives. Will share more as more becomes available, such as a draft plan. Joel mentions that the SEOW group should have data and infographics should assist and support the introduction of the need within the plan.
- **Bureau of Health and Wellness/Division of Chronic Disease and Injury Control/ Tobacco Section/Injury and Violence Prevention Unit – Chelsea Walker**
 - **Data Driven Prevention Initiative for Prescription Drug Overdose**

Strategic plan update – Written into their 3-year continuation application to dedicate some of the supplemental funds received to help in the process of developing the draft strategic plan. Will begin next fiscal year and will be coordinated by the Michigan Public Health Institute (MPHI), needs are being identified.

Year Three continuation application - submitted on May 1, 2018. Will continue to fund our present contractors for prescriber education, and outreach and cc guidelines, etc. Will conduct an academic detailers search to be carried out by the Oakland County Health Department, Center for Rural Health, and a few other contractors. Will continue to work with the University of Michigan (U of M) Injury Center. Michigan specific tools and other items will be developed through the U of M of which topics are to be determined. Will be working with the U of M to enhance the System for Opioid Overdose Surveillance (S.O.S) program to expand to other counties. June 4, 2018, will be the next prescription drug overdose stakeholder meeting to discuss workplans and learn their progress. Hired our last Public Health Consultant.
- **Bureau of Epidemiology and Population Health/Division of Environmental Health/Environmental Surveillance Section – Ashley Miller/Gabrielle Stroh Steiner**
 - **Michigan Opioid Morbidity and Mortality Surveillance**

Sarah is our new EPI injury hire, who is working on Michigan Opioid Morbidity and Mortality Surveillance (MOMMs). Grant application submitted the end of April. Future funding is uncertain. Working on our supplemental with toxicology enhancement to conduct more comprehensive testing on fentanyl. Plans are in the works for strategy three (dissemination plans), annual or bi-annual county specific and Michigan focus monthly. The plan is to share drafts with this group. Working with the U of M on the SOS project.
- **2016 Drug Poisoning Deaths Infographic (telling the story in pictures/visuals) - Su Min Oh/Patrick Hindman**
 - An overview of the infographic was communicated to the group based on suggestions and comments from the group; stating the statistics; high and low over time. More suggestions were communicated from the group.
- **Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS) Factsheet – Megan Walsh**

Megan updated the existing NAS Factsheet using stats from 2010 to 2016 and she described how and what changes were made. The next step is for the factsheet to go to Communications for approval, after which we can be posted and used.
