OROSC Updates – Larry Scott

- **State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant Application** – Submitted for 27.5 M yesterday, August 14, 2018 for year one. If approved, the award will start October 1, 2018.
- **Federal Site Visit** – Went over various data of the details about this site visit. Overall it was productive. A report on the outcome will be sent in 60 days and will be shared with this group.

Opioids and Prescription Drugs, Alcohol, Heroin, Marijuana, E-Cigarettes - Su Min Oh/Group

- **Michigan Opioid Laws** –
- **Prescription Drugs** – There has been a slight decrease in deaths. Many initiatives going on to combat this.
- **Heroin** – 2017 data indicates there has been an increase in deaths.
- **Legalizing Marijuana** – Will be on the November 2018 ballot.

- **E-Cigarettes** – No new information

Corbin Stanley, a doctoral student from Michigan State University introduced himself stating his background and purpose regarding his document on suicide. Mr. Corbin’s presentation *Tri-County Lifesavers Suicide Preliminary Data Report* was sent to this group prior to this meeting. Mr. Corbin explained the details of the report; data, and what can be done to lower suicide rates, among others. He also shared some of the risk factors, data/statistics, and results, as well as preventive measures to combat youth suicide. He also talked about plans for a phase two.
