Update on Next Steps/Action Items from Previous Meeting – Joel Hoepfner

- EPI Profile feedback provided to Su Min as requested and is now with Communications to approve.
- Provide feedback on the Substance Exposures Report to Liz – Distribute widely

- Encourage and Share the whole Central Data Repository (CDR) website pointing out the opioid tab to networks and communities

OROSC Updates – Larry Scott

- **Naloxone Standing Order** - Over 1400 pharmacies are now participating and as of today has reached 49 percent.
- **Injecting Drug Users** – Safe places for those who inject drugs to go and inject drugs. Further research will be conducted.

Emerging Issues and Trends - All

Opioids and Prescription Drugs, Alcohol, Heroin, Marijuana, E-Cigarettes - Su Min Oh/Group

- **Infographic Development** – Su Min reported that the infographic is still with the Communications area for approval. She is also requesting everyone to review the data briefs and send comments to her at Ohs@michigan.gov. She goes on to describe the findings, from the 2001 – 2006 trend data, such as prescription drugs and opioids, among others, including most concentrated regions. Will be added to the CDR.

Alcohol – The Half Mile Rule has been removed by the Liquor Commission and the bill (HB 54504 and SB 501) is in the House and Senate to make it a law is in progress. Information was related to the group about the Sunset .08 bill. Dr. Ferholden will be here to do some outreach and outlet density research. Additional information on Fetal Alcohol syndrome legislation bill which would require outlets to post signs that say, “drinking while pregnant will harm your baby.”

- **Opioids and Prescription Drugs** – Sixteen bills are waiting for approval in either the House or Senate and will be reported after they are passed.
- **Heroin** – N/A
- **E-Cigarettes** – N/A
- **Marijuana** – Fentanyl laced marijuana has been reported. Su Min will check with the Poison Control Center and report to everyone.

Office of Highway Safety Planning (OHSP) – *Dianne Perukel - Tabled*

Syringe Service Programs – *Kim filling in for Joe Coyle*

There are three new Syringe Service Programs (Lansing, Muskegon, and Petoskey), as well as the others mentioned in the 10/18/17. New outbreak summary of Hep A is on our website at www.Michigan.gov/hepAoutbreak. Stats indicate 495 cases; 84% have been hospitalized with 19 deaths. She also gave other category stats. The Syringe Service Program was explained to the members. Joel suggests the HEP A website be added to the CDR and make it stand out.

Data Driven Prevention Initiative for Prescription Drug Overdose – *Chelsea Walker*

- Contracts started November 1 for seven contractors in three pilot communities (Marquette County Health Department, Macomb County Health Department, Catholic Human Services (Alpena and Montmorency) counties that are working on developing their own data surveillance system and prescriber education.
- Stakeholder meeting this week that involved the strategic plan and preparing a draft for review.

System for Opioid Overdose Surveillance (S.O.S.) - *Mashid Abir, MD and Amanda Kogowski*

- Su Min welcomed Dr. Abir and Ms. Kogowski, as well as gave a short background of their profiles.
- Amanda went on to explain what High Intensity Drug Traffic Area (HIDTA) is and how it works, as well as their work with HIDTA.
- Dr. Abir presented a PowerPoint (sent to everyone prior to this meeting) on data related to the opioid overdose surveillance and how they work with and respond to the data. Data is recent (two weeks ago) and is obtained through an online system, as well as how they work with the medical examiner offices. Questions were asked, and answers were offered. Joel thanked Dr. Abir and Ms. Kogowski for coming.
