Sec. 531. Section 1.4 Service Planning and Delivery is revised to remove the requirement for DHHS to initiate a new Individual Service Agreement, DHS-3600, if the child remains in the Contractor's care beyond 10 months. Section 2.9 Compliance Requirements is revised to include compliance with 2017 Public Acts 246 through 255, Michigan Opioid Laws; Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Section 504 Protecting Students with Disabilities; Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) as per the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; and Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA). Section 2.10 Services to be Provided, a. Residential Care is revised to include the following residential program types: Specialized Developmental Disability, Intensive Stabilization, and Human Trafficking. Section 2.10 Services to be Provided, d. Staffing is revised to allow for a bachelor's degree in a human services/education field for the Educational Planner/Permanency Planning Specialist. Section 2.10 Services to be Provided, p. Education has been revised. Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) to all students with disabilities has been added as a possible educational service. Tutorial services shall not be a substitute for special education and related services. Section 2.23 Criminal Background Check has been added. Administrative and/or minor changes were made throughout.
