

Qualifying Hospice Residences Requirements

(FY2018 Appropriation Act - Public Act 107 of 2017)

September 15, 2018

Sec. 1856. (1) *The funds appropriated in part 1 for hospice services shall be expended to provide room and board for Medicaid recipients who meet hospice eligibility requirements and receive services at Medicaid enrolled hospice residences in this state. The qualifying hospice residences must have been enrolled with Medicaid by October 1, 2014. The department and a representation of eligible recipients shall form a workgroup to determine how to better streamline the current payment methodology while ensuring fiscal accountability by January 1, 2018.*

(2) By September 15 of the current fiscal year, qualifying hospice residences receiving funds under this section shall submit to the department, the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on the department budget, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget office a report that includes, but is not limited to, all of the following: (a) The number of patients served. (b) The number of days served. (c) The total cost of services provided. (d) The per patient cost of services provided. (e) The number of patients who did not receive care.

(3) At the end of the current fiscal year, any unexpended funds shall lapse back to the general fund.
