

# Report on Contractual Expenses Incurred

(FY2018 Appropriation Act - Public Act 107 of 2017)

December 31, 2017

***Sec. 1882. By December 31 of the current fiscal year, the department shall report to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on the department budget, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget office, documentation of the expenses incurred during the immediate preceding fiscal year by Medicaid health plans and PIHPs for the purpose of meeting the contractual requirements to join the Michigan Health Information Network Shared Services and incentivizing providers to become members of the Health Information Exchange Qualified Organization. The report should also include an estimation of the expenses to be incurred in the current fiscal year by Medicaid health plans and PIHPs for the same purpose of meeting their contractual obligations.***

## Michigan Health Information Network Shared Services (MiHIN) Expenses

	FY17 Costs-Actual	FY18 Costs-Estimated
Medicaid Health Plans	\$ 0	\$1,173,622
Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans	\$48,812	\$ 161,681

Notes:

- Costs represent all costs paid directly to MiHIN (participation fees, use case costs, etc.).
- MiHIN offered incentives to early adopter plans which either waived or significantly reduced the participation costs for both Medicaid Health Plans and Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans.
- State Innovation Model Federal funding was leveraged to cover any remaining MiHIN costs for the Medicaid Health Plans in Fiscal Year (FY) 17. These costs will be covered directly by the Medicaid Health Plans in FY18.
