# **GF/GP Lapses Report**

(FY2021 Appropriation Act - Public Act 166 of 2020)

### November 30, 2020

Sec. 209. Not later than November 30, the state budget office shall prepare and transmit a report that provides for estimates of the total general fund/general purpose appropriation lapses at the close of the prior fiscal year. This report shall summarize the projected year-end general fund/general purpose appropriation lapses by major departmental program or program areas. The report shall be transmitted to the chairpersons of the senate and house appropriations committees, and the senate and house fiscal agencies.

The report of estimated appropriation year 2020 general fund, general purpose lapses required by Public Act 56 of 2019 is attached.

Departments are not scheduled to be complete with year-end transaction processing until mid-December. As a result, the department-level lapse amounts included in the attached report are based on preliminary estimates provided by the departments, rather than preliminary book closing data from the state's accounting system. We will provide an updated report based on preliminary book closing data, which shows estimated lapses by appropriation category, as soon as possible. At that time, we will also provide a report of estimated lapses by line item appropriation to the Senate Fiscal Agency and House Fiscal Agency.
