

NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES TO CHILD WELFARE MASTER CONTRACT(S)

(FY2018 Appropriation Bill - Public Act 107 of 2017)

Not Less than 30 Days before the change takes effect

Section 531: *The department shall notify the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on the department budget, the house and senate fiscal agencies, and the house and senate policy offices of any changes to a child welfare master contract template, including the adoption master contract template, the independent living plus master contract template, the child placing agency foster care master contract template, and the residential foster care juvenile justice master contract template, not less than 30 days before the change takes effect.*

The amended Independent Living Program (ILP) master contract has been posted to the MDHHS public website in the Master Contract Templates section at:

Changes were made to the ILP master contract. The training requirements within the Credentials section have been revised for staff, first line supervisors, and supervisors who have transferred to a foster care position. Training requirements have been added for staff who perform functions related to the certification of foster homes as well as supervisors. Requirements set forth in MDHHS Services Requirements Manual 103 must be adhered to by the contractor. The OWDT Registration Process has been revised. Services related to MiTEAM requirements have been added. Billing language has been changed to limit the number of years that MDHHS will honor a payment request for services provided. The per diem rate(s) for both host homes and staff-supported homes have been added. The types of training courses which are eligible for reimbursement have been revised. Minor programmatic and administrative changes were also made.
