

Services received by treatment non-complete vs. discharge clients

This graphic compares services received between treatment non-complete clients and clients discharged from treatment/recovery programming. Treatment non-complete clients have either been terminated from programming or stopped engaging in programming. These clients are no longer receiving services.

Clients who successfully discharge from treatment receive more recovery support, peer coaching or mentoring, and recovery coaching services than treatment non-complete clients.



Clients who complete programming are more likely to receive peer services, but clients who do not complete programming are more likely to receive non-peer related services including assessment, treatment/recovery planning, screening, case management, individual counseling, relapse prevention, alcohol/drug testing, brief intervention, medical care and individual services.
