MiTracking - Description

- MiTracking gathers existing Michigan-specific environmental and health data and provides them in one online location. MiTracking has data tables, graphs, maps, informational resources, and more.
- Website: michigan.gov/MiTracking



Data Portal - How To

- To access data, simply click on the “Go to Data” button and agree to the Terms of Use.
- In the portal, searches are narrowed based on area of interest. Data are selected by category, content area, indicator, and measure.
- To view results, select “Run Query.”
- For advanced searches, select “Switch to Advanced Query” for more search options.
- To compare measures, select “Compare Measures.”
- Results are viewed in interactive tables, charts, and maps. Results can be saved, shared, and downloaded.

These data can be easily queried on the MiTracking data portal. Results are provided in tables, charts, and maps that can be downloaded, saved, and printed. The data provided by the MiTracking program can create greater awareness of environmental health concerns, and inform public health actions and programs.

USING MITRACKING - MICHIGAN ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH TRACKING

The MiTracking-Michigan Environmental Public Health Tracking database is located on the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services website.

Located in the middle of the page shown below, the MiTracking database gathers Michigan-specific environmental and health data in an easily searchable location. The purpose of the MiTracking database is to provide greater awareness to Michigan residents of environmental health concerns, and to inform residents about public health initiatives and programs.
