This care includes medical attention, a detailed forensic exam and prophylactic medication as indicated.</p> <p>The Forensic Examiners (FEs) are specially trained to perform medical forensic examinations of adolescent and adult victims of acute sexual assault. They collect evidence from suspects in police custody and work with victims. They are also trained in giving court testimony.</p>

Mott Children’s Hospital who require emergency care; including possible evidence collection in cases of sexual assault/sexual abuse. <b>HOWEVER</b>, please contact the child protection team (available 24/7) prior to sending a child to CES if the child requires medical evaluation, but not urgently.</p> <p><b>INPATIENT UNITS:</b>          C.S. Mott Children’s Hospital Inpatient Units/Michigan Medicine Burn Unit available to children requiring admission.</p> <p><b>OUTPATIENT CLINICS:</b>          The Child Protection Team has outpatient Suspected Child Abuse and Neglect (SCAN) Clinics at the Washtenaw County Child Advocacy Center; West Ann Arbor Health Center; and in the Pediatric Subspecialty Clinic at C.S. Mott Children’s Hospital. The clinics are staffed by two pediatricians board-certified in Child Abuse Pediatrics and a Pediatric Nurse Practitioner who is supervised by the pediatricians. This service has been available for the last two years.</p> <p style="color: red;">The clinic has now expanded services by offering a virtual platform for initial, periodic and annual exams for children in foster care if a child’s regular medical provider is not scheduling well-child exams or is unable to provide the exam using telemedicine. The caregiver needs a computer, tablet or phone and access to the internet in order for a child to have a virtual exam. The process for referral remains the same; HLOs make the referral. HLOs for these counties have been notified of the expanded services and will reach out to foster care staff in their counties with the update.</p>

Frequently concerns such as head trauma, acute (fresh) injuries, emergent sexual assault, and others may be directed to the Pediatric Emergency Department at Helen DeVos Children’s Hospital for immediate evaluation and CCP coordination. Arrangements for forensic evidence (rape kit) collection is done on a case-by-case basis. Non-emergent but urgent concerns will also be addressed by CCP Triage on a case-by-case basis. Please call CCP triage to utilize any of these services.</p> <p><b>Inpatient Consultation:</b> Center for Child Protection physicians consult for children that required admission to the General Pediatric floors, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Pediatric Burn unit.</p>

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		<p><b>Outpatient Clinics:</b> The Center for Child Protection is located at 330 Barclay Ave. Grand Rapids, MI. Children are seen for any form of abuse or neglect. The Center for Child Protection has also partnered with several Michigan Children's Advocacy Center's (Barry, Clare, Gratiot, Montcalm, Ionia, Isabella, Oceana) to provide medical evaluation at our 330 Barclay address. On-site medical services are provided at the Allegan, Muskegon and Ottawa County Children's Advocacy Centers for children living in those counties.</p> <p><b>Other Services:</b> <b>Child pornography reviews-</b> please contact Center for Child Protection Triage for specific information. <b>Case reviews-</b> at this time a medical opinion is not provided based solely upon review of medical records and photo-documentation. A child can be seen for an outpatient appointment with injuries that have resolved if there is photo-documentation of previous injury or evidence of previous injury on the body (healed scarring). At that time review of previous medical records can be done and used in the formation of a diagnosis. <b>Photo-documentation of acute injuries-</b> as arranged by CCP triage coordinators- call for further information. <b>Education and Training-</b> Addressing the needs of CPS, law enforcement and medical providers. Call for further information. <b>Peer Review-</b> ongoing statewide medical provider Peer Review.</p> <p>To reduce the health-risk for exposure, no non-urgent examinations should be sought. The Center for Child Protection is currently responding for emergencies and inpatients. Our local YWCA SANE program is also operational at this time.
