Air Force Program

- Committed to safety and well-being of the general public both on and off Air Force installations.
- Identify all locations where Air Force has reason to suspect a release of PFOS/PFOA
- Identify PFOA/PFOS exposure, if any, above EPA provisional health advisory (PHA)
- Mitigate exposures above PHA




PFC Program Timeline

- 1970: Aqueous Film Forming Foam (AFFF) is used at AF bases
- 2011: MDEQ samples fish
- Spring 2012: MDHHS issues advisory
- Fall 2012: A base-wide site screening & detailed Fire Training Pit (FT-02) delineation was initiated
- Spring 2013: Site screening completed
- 2013: A Focused Feasibility Study initiated for FT-02
- Spring 2014: Contract for groundwater containment system was awarded
- April 2015: System started operation
- 2015: Air Force completes base wide records review to identify additional areas with likely AFFF releases
- Winter 2015: Residential well survey and PFC sampling initiated
- Spring 2016: Expected completion of well survey & sampling



2015 Progress

- Completed construction and startup of PTS at FT-02 upgradient of Clarks Marsh
 - System creates a roughly 2000 ft to intercept groundwater coming from FT-02 that is heading toward marsh
 - System construction cost \$2.4M and \$400K annual operations and maintenance
- PTS operation began in April
 - pumped approximately 80 million gallons in first 8 months
- Initial data indicates significant drop in concentrations downgradient of system
- Records review to identify potential PFC release sites completed
- Residential well sampling identified potentially impacted wells and sampling completed in December



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
Path Forward

2016

- Continue PTS operation
- Complete residential well survey and sampling
- Conduct site assessments at 15 locations with suspected PFC releases
- Continue monitoring of fish tissue at Clark's Marsh



2016 Investigation



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


Private Well Survey

- In the fall of 2015, the Air Force contracted with Amec Foster Wheeler to inventory and sample private wells with potential AFFF impacts
- Identified private wells in coordination with MDEQ to sample
- Sampled Whispering Woods in September 2015
- Sampled private wells which were accessible in December
- Seasonally occupied homes will be sampled when owners return



Survey Area



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Private Well Sample Results

■ EPA Provisional Health Advisory

- PFOS = 200 ppt; PFOA = 400 ppt
- All sample results were well below PHA
- Whispering Woods results
 - PFOS 6 ppt and 9.6 ppt; PFOA non-detect
- 23 residential locations with wells sampled
 - 8 wells with PFOS and/or PFOA
 - PFOS from 10.6 ppt to 27.8 ppt
 - PFOA from 17.7 ppt to 51 ppt
