¹Medicare Part B covers influenza and pneumonia vaccines, Hepatitis B for intermediate to high-risk beneficiaries and medically necessary vaccines to treat illness or injury (e.g., Td for wounds). If roster billing is utilized, you may roster bill influenza and pneumococcal vaccines, but you cannot roster bill the hepatitis B vaccine.

²Medicare Part D plans generally cover ACIP routinely recommended vaccines **that are not covered in Part B**. Language specific to Hepatitis A vaccine indicates coverage “when medically necessary.”
