
Learning Management System (LMS) Quick Reference – Gray Courses

Grayed Out Courses

After you log into the courses.mihealth.org Learning Management System (LMS), you may notice that some of your courses are grayed out, like in the image below:




When courses are grayed out in the LMS, it means there is a prerequisite (another course you need to take in order to access the grayed out courses).

Prerequisites

In the image below, notice the **Prerequisites** column for the "MI-WIC Clerk Training" and the "MI-WIC CPA Training" courses. They both have "M0800" listed as a prerequisite.



This tells you that you need to take the MO800 MI-WIC All Clinic Staff Training course before you can take the MI-WIC Clerk Training and MI-WIC CPA Training courses.

Using the example above, when you complete the MI-WIC All Clinic Staff Training course in the LMS, the Clerk Training and CPA Training courses will no longer be grayed out and will be available for you to take.



No longer grayed out courses are ready for you to take!
