




Current Cigarette Smoking Rates Among High School Students in Michigan from 1997-2023 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS)






Current Tobacco Use Rates Among High School Students in Michigan from 1999-2023 YBRS















Percentages of High School Students Who Ever Tried Smoking Cigarettes Compared to Current Cigarette Smokers, YRBS






Percentages of High School Students Who Ever Tried Ecigarette Compared to Current E-cigarettes Users, YRBS.






Percentages of High School Students Who are Currently Smoking Cigarettes Compared to Currently Using E-cigarette Overtime, YRBS 2015-2023






Current Michigan Adult Smoking Rates by Gender BRFSS 2013-2023






Michigan High School Cigarette and E-Cigarette Use Rate by Gender, YRBS 2023









Michigan Current High School Tobacco Users and the Percentage of Users who Tried Quitting in the Past Year, YRBS 2015-2023







Michigan High School Cigarette and E-Cigarette Use Rate by Race/Ethnicity, YRBS 2023








How Old You Were When First Tried Using E-cigarette






Current Tobacco Users Who Reported that Someone Living in their House are Using one of the Various Tobacco Products, 2023 MYTS






Exposure to Smoke from Any Tobacco Products Over the Past 7 Days Among Student, 2023 MYTS


















Brands of E-cigarettes Tried by Students in Michigan Compared to the National Rate, 2023 MYTS





Students Perceptions about Tobacco Use Among Their Peers, 2023 MYTS








Rates of Current Tobacco Use Among Transgender Students in Michigan Compared to the National Rate (NYTS), 2023 MYTS






Rates of Current Tobacco Use Among LGBTQ Students in Michigan Compared to the National Rate, 2023 MYTS/NYTS











Category 1: Prohibition of tobacco use within buildings at all times, but outdoor use is allowed after 6 p.m. on regularly scheduled school days, during weekends Category 2: Prohibition of tobacco use that applies to everyone on school grounds but not at off-grounds school-sponsored events.


Category 3: Prohibition of tobacco use that applies to everyone at all times, on-campus and off-campus at school-sponsored events.

Category 4: Has the same degree of prohibition as category 3, but also includes e-cigarettes and other next-generation tobacco products. This is the most comprehensive policy category.


