## VII. MDHHS Human Trafficking Grants Updates

- Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) issued two Request for Proposals (RFPs) for human trafficking grants
- Community Services Grant encourages organizations to bring together stakeholders in communities to identify gaps in services for survivors and create common processes and channels of communication between groups
- Hospital/ER Human Trafficking Protocol Pilot Program Grant is for hospitals to work with community partners to develop a protocol in their ER or entire hospital for identifying, assessing, treating, and referring victims. The grantee will submit a report at the end of the grant with "lessons learned"/recommendations from the pilot. The plan is to have the grantee present at future meetings to give updates on their pilot.
- Awards will be announced by MDHHS in mid-July

## VIII. Human Trafficking Public Awareness Campaign

- Chair Kommareddi and Jon met with MDHHS staff, Michigan Dep. of Civil Rights, and Michigan Office of New Americans to discuss raising awareness about human trafficking in at-risk populations like immigrants, refugees, and migrant laborers.
- MDHHS is planning to develop some outreach materials and partner with media outlets and community organizations that work with these groups to target these populations.

  generally people should contact the National Human Trafficking Hotline who can connect
  them with the appropriate parties in Michigan. 2-1-1 was also mentioned as a possibility for
  connecting survivors w/ services, but we don't know how knowledgeable 2-1-1 is of human
  trafficking and related services
