Changes to the *Design – Utilities: Subsurface Utility Engineering* Prequalification Classification Requirements

The information below summarizes changes to the *Design – Utilities: Subsurface Utility Engineering* prequalification classification requirements:

Definition/Use Statement

- Modified to better suit the expectations for this category

Equipment/Software

- Removed the requirement of survey equipment
- Refined the “designating equipment” requirement
- Removed the requirement for vacuum extraction equipment

Resources

- Removed MicroStation (Required in Equipment/Software Section)

Staff Education / Experience

- Refined the Engineer experience requirement
- Added the utility designator staff requirement

Other Requirements

- Refined the project deliverable requirements

All firm’s currently prequalified in the *Design – Utilities: Subsurface Utility Engineering* classification will be required to supply a revised application demonstrating compliance within 30 calendar days of formal notification. Current prequalified firms will be contacted directly.
