


New Bidder Registration Instructions for MDOT Online Excess Property Auctions with BidCorp

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is expanding the way it sells excess real estate to now include online auctions. Thru BidCorp.com, MDOT will post property from around the State that has been determined to no longer be necessary for transportation purposes. To ensure you have access to MDOT's online real estate auctions, interested parties will need to register at BidCorp.com. Step-by-step instructions are provided below on how to register and sign up for notifications when MDOT auctions are posted.

New Bidder Registration Instructions

1. To register as a bidder on BidCorp.com, go to <https://www.bidcorp.com> and click on "Sign Up"

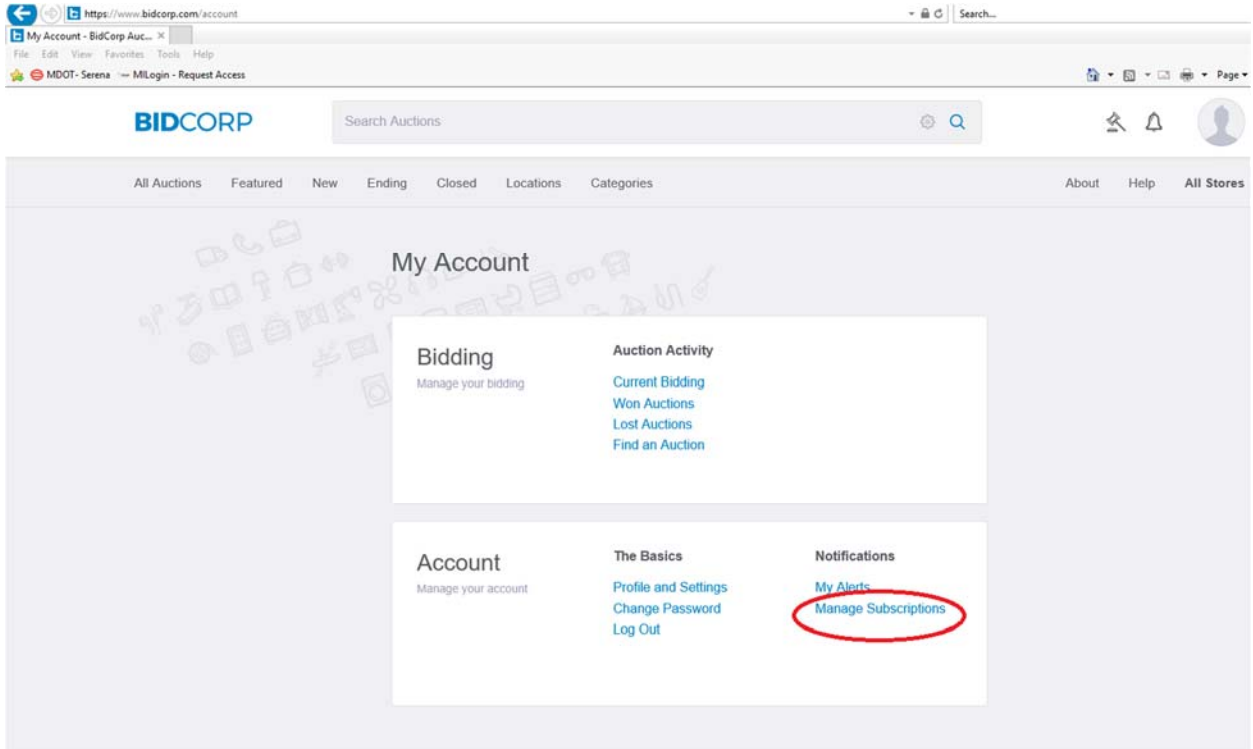
3. Upon receiving a registration confirmation email from BidCorp, click on the validation link in the email to activate your Bidcorp account

NOTE: You cannot access your account until you have activated it by clicking on the validation link

4. After clicking the validation link, log in to set up your Account Profile

Setting Up Your Bidder Preferences

1. Once users have registered with BidCorp and set up your Account Profile, you can Manage Subscriptions



2. To ensure users receive email notifications on auctions, users should select auction categories of interest to them under the Select Auction Categories. MDOT Excess Property Auctions are likely to be under the following categories: Vacant land, Commercial Real Estate, and Residential Real Estate.
