

## Environmental Sensor Station Installation Design-Build Project Information Sheet

The Michigan Department of Transportation intends on using a Design-Build contracting method to install Environmental Sensor Stations (ESS) in the Superior Region. This project is listed as Item 601 in the May 13, 2015 letting

The Project is located in 8 to 12 locations in Gogebic, Ontonagon, Baraga, Alger, Delta, Schoolcraft, Luce, Mackinac, Chippewa, Keweenaw, Iron, Dickinson, and Menominee counties.

This work may include any of the following: Installing towers or poles, conduit, power meter and distribution at each location. Installation of equipment into existing traffic signal cabinets. Equipment installation may include remote processing units, cellular modems, invasive and noninvasive environmental sensor, cameras, traffic data collection sensors, etc.
