

## **I-75 Rehabilitation; Ogemaw County Design Build Information Sheet**

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) intends on using a Design-Build procurement method to deliver a road rehabilitation project in the North Region. MDOT plans to issue a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) in early May. MDOT expects to release a draft Request for Proposals (RFP) to short-listed Proposers in late June 2016. The RFP is substantially complete, but funding will not be available until the next fiscal year, which is when the advertisement will occur (early October 2016). The project letting is expected to occur in early December 2016 and construction is expected to be substantially complete by November 2017.

The project is located in Ogemaw County. The project on I-75 Northbound and Southbound runs from the Arenac County line northerly to the bridge over Cook Road. The project will also utilize an alternate pavement bid and two alternates for pavement rehabilitation have been identified.

- Alternate #1 is rubblizing the existing concrete pavement and overlaying with hot mix asphalt.
- Alternate #2 is an unbonded concrete overlay of the existing concrete pavement.

The project also includes bridge approach work, pavement reconstruction of freeway ramps at the West Branch Rest Area and at the Cook Road interchange (southern two ramps only), pavement reconstruction of the truck parking lot within the West Branch Rest Area, replacement of three median crossovers, culvert extensions and replacements, guardrail replacement, pavement markings, and ROW fence replacement.

A DBE goal of 7% is anticipated for this project.
