






I-94 Operations Study Glossary

<p>Flex Route</p>	<p>A lane control system that uses cameras and signs to let drivers know when the shoulder is available as an additional travel lane during peak travel periods.</p>	 <p>US-23 Flex Route shoulder operations and gantry.</p>
<p>Collector-Distributor (CD)</p>	<p>A roadway between the freeway and adjacent local road network with a primary purpose of moving weaving and lane-changing traffic away from the high-speed freeway traffic. CD roadways “collect” and “distribute” the weaving traffic as vehicles move from the freeway to the local roadways (and vice versa).</p>	 <p>Collector-Distributor road between mainline freeway adjacent to local road network.</p>
<p>Weave</p>	<p>A section of freeway where both traffic entering from an on ramp and exiting to an exit ramp must interact with each other and “weave” across each other’s paths in order to properly enter or exit the freeway.</p>	 <p>Exiting and entering vehicles weaving to get across each other’s paths.</p>
<p>Flyover</p>	<p>A ramp that crosses over (or under) another roadway.</p>	 <p>Ramp crossing over another ramp.</p>
<p>Acceleration Lane</p>	<p>A speed change area or lane consisting of added pavement at the edge of through-traffic lanes to permit vehicles to accelerate before merging with the through-traffic flow.</p>	 <p>Additional pavement at the edge of a lane to allow for speeding up.</p>
