What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be repaving more than 7 miles of I-94 from Red Arrow Highway in Bridgman to Puetz Road in Stevensville, Berrien County. Construction includes bridge repairs, guardrail replacement, and new signs and culverts.

When Will This Be Done?

Construction is scheduled to begin in March, and completion is anticipated in October.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

There will be daily single-lane closures and nighttime double-lane closures on I-94. Puetz Road will be closed at I-94 and detoured. There will be temporary ramp closures at Exit 16 Red Arrow Highway in Bridgman, and Exit 22 Grand Mere Road in Stevensville.

Long-term Benefits

The road and bridge project supports the creation of jobs, growth of the economy, preservation of the environment and the safety and security of the transportation system.
