

What Is Being Done?

Starting this spring, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will repair several bridges along I-96 at the following locations:

- Cedar Street
- I-96 Business Loop ramps (BL)
- Sycamore Creek
- J & L Railroad
- Aurelius Road (over I-96)

Construction is expected to last until this fall.



How Will Traffic Be Affected?

During construction, two lanes will be open in each direction on I-96 using an innovative construction method called a split-merge traffic system. This system maintains two lanes of traffic in each direction by crossing one lane of traffic over to the opposite side of the freeway and maintaining a local lane on the original side of the freeway.

Throughout the length of the construction zone, there will be three lanes of traffic on one side of the freeway (two lanes in one direction and a through-lane in the opposite direction), and one local lane on the opposite side.

Local impacts during construction include:

- Aurelius Road will be closed over I-96 with a detour posted.
- I-96 BL ramps and Cedar Street will have one lane open in each direction.
- The Sycamore Creek Path under I-96, just east of Cedar Street, will remain open using part-width construction.
