Resurfacing and Concrete Pavement Repairs

Ottawa and Kent Counties

Mid-April - Mid-August 2019

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest \$3 million to resurface and repair approximately 13 miles of I-96 from 68th Avenue to Bristol Avenue in Ottawa and Kent counties.

When Will This Be Done?

Work will begin in mid-April and is scheduled to be completed by mid-August.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Weekend single-lane closures will be in effect through the end of May on I-96 from Bristol Avenue to 16th Avenue. From June to mid-August, weekday lane closures will be in place from 16th Avenue to 68th Avenue.

Intermittent nightly single-lane closures will be used throughout the project and each ramp within the project limits will be closed for one night during resurfacing.
