

I-96 Pavement Repairs and Bridge Replacement Ionia County

Mid-March - Mid-October 2019

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest \$3.9 million to remove and replace the original Cutler Road bridge over I-96, and \$5.5 million to repair and resurface 9.5 miles of I-96 from Sunfield Road to the Ionia/Clinton county line.

When Will This Be Done?

Work will begin in mid-March and is scheduled to be completed by mid-October.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Single-lane closures and traffic shifts will be in effect for most of the project. I-96 will be closed and detoured for bridge demolition and beam setting. Ramps within the project limits will be closed and detoured intermittently for resurfacing.

I-96 traffic will be detoured on M-43, M-66 and Grand River Avenue. Cutler Road traffic will be detoured on Grand River Avenue, Peake Road and Monroe Avenue.
