

Westbound I-196 Bridge Widening and Reconstruction Grand Rapids

April 1 - Aug. 31, 2019


What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is investing \$21.4 million to widen and reconstruct the westbound I-196 bridge over the Grand River at the US-131 interchange. The project includes deck replacement, painting, barrier wall replacement, and substructure reinforcement.

The wider bridge will accommodate wider shoulders and additional lanes to better connect westbound I-196 to the US-131 interchange.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Westbound I-196 will be closed at Ottawa Avenue with no access to US-131, and through-traffic will be detoured onto westbound I-96 to southbound US-131. All ramps at the I-196/US-131 interchange are subject to periodic closures throughout the project.
