### Local Agency Public Meetings

Public meetings are defined as those meetings that a Local Agency hosts to inform and gather input from the public on a project, or a list of projects, with potential benefits and/or adverse effects on the community.

Local Agencies are required by the Federal Highway Administration to request and collect certain demographic data from public meeting participants if the public meeting participants are willing to volunteer the information.

Form 5400-LA provides guidance to capture required demographic information as required in 23 CFR 200.9 (b)(4).
