

M-11 Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC)

The MDOT is proceeding with a Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC) procurement method for a project on M-11 from M-37/M-44 easterly to the Westbound I-96 Ramps, in the cities of Kentwood and Grand Rapids, Cascade Township, Kent County. The project includes the rehabilitation and reconstruction of M-11, from M-37/M-44 east to I-96. It is separated into two distinct sections of work. M-11, from M-37/M-44 east to 450' west of Patterson Avenue will be rehabilitated, with coldmilling and two course HMA resurfacing, including ADA ramps and signal work. The HMA paving portion of this work is currently planned to be constructed at night and during off-peak hours, to limit impacts to the adjacent businesses. The Reconstruction portion of the project starts approximately 450' west of Patterson Avenue and continues easterly to the I-96 ramps. This portion of the project consists of a full roadway concrete reconstruction including curb and gutter, drainage and safety, and signal upgrades, ADA ramps, local participation for the addition of sidewalk and lighting.

The anticipated construction prequalification is 7000Cb/Ea or 7000B.
