Mackinac Bridge Authority to meet virtually next week

September 24, 2020 -- Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Mackinac Bridge Authority (MBA) again will meet virtually Thursday, Oct. 1.

The MBA Finance Committee is scheduled to meet at 9 a.m. followed by the MBA's regular board meeting at 10:30 a.m. The meetings will be conducted on the Microsoft Teams platform.
