Dear Members of the Michigan Legislature:

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is pleased to present you with the 2011-2015 Five-Year Transportation Program. It can be accessed on our website at www.michigan.gov/mdot5yearplan. This plan is awaiting approval from the State Transportation Commission at their March 31, 2011 meeting. Section 307 of 2010 PA 192 requires the Department to provide this plan to the Michigan Legislature, the State Budget Office, and the House and Senate Fiscal Agencies.

The Five-Year Transportation Program demonstrates our commitment to providing Michigan citizens with the highest quality integrated transportation services for economic benefit and improved quality of life. The 2011-2015 program represents an approximately \$6.1 billion investment in MDOT's transportation system, including roads and bridges, non-motorized transportation, and aviation, bus, rail and marine/port programs for the current program. Each year, an average of \$124 million will be invested in the aviation program and \$282 million will be invested in bus, rail and marine/port programs. An annual average of \$820 million will be invested in the highway program.
