

## Jobsite Posters

The Federal Highway Administration requires contractors to prominently display posters in areas available to employees and applicants for employment during the life of the project. Complete form 1967, Jobsite Poster Inspection Checklist, during the start of the construction project. This form is an aid to make sure that the contractor is following the proper procedure, as required per the specifications. This form must be in the project files.
