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

Pavement Marking Material Product Change

This construction advisory is to notify field staff of a pavement marking material update.

The newest revision to the QPL Section 811.03D5 lists 3M Cold Plastic Tapes 380AW and 381AW in place of 380WR and 381WR.

This is due to the manufacturer request: 'AW' (All-Weather) is a replacement for 'WR' (Wet Reflective).

Because WR tape was not removed from the QPL due to poor performance, time is being allowed for the contractors to deplete their current stock. The contractor may use 380WR and 381WR until September 30, 2011.

For those performing material inspections, Form 1585 has been created for your use, if desired. 380AW, 381AW, 380WR and 381WR will be listed on this form until September 30, 2011 – at which time the WR designations will be removed.
