What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is repaving I-94 near the M-311 (11 Mile Road) interchange, including the M-311 (11 Mile Road) ramps in Battle Creek.

When Will This Be Done?

Work is scheduled to take place in May.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Two lanes of I-94 will be open in each direction during the day with nighttime single-lane closures. The ramps will remain open during construction.

Long-term Benefits

The new asphalt on I-94 and the ramps will improve safety and serve motorists for many years to come.
