

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is reconstructing the Sprinkle Road bridge over I-94 in Kalamazoo. The Sprinkle Road interchange at I-94 is being replaced with a dual roundabout-style interchange, and the Cork Street bridge over I-94 is being removed.

When Will This Be Done?

Construction is expected to start in March and be completed in November.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Sprinkle Road will be reduced to one lane open in each direction. Interchange traffic will be detoured to adjacent interchanges. I-94 will be reduced to one lane in each direction during off-peak hours.

Long-term Benefits

This project will provide a new bridge carrying Sprinkle Road traffic over I-94 and will replace the existing congested interchange with an interchange better equipped to handle high traffic volumes.
