What Is Being Done?

Resurfacing nearly a mile of M-66 from Condensery Road to just north of Liberty Street (north village limits) of Sheridan. Work also includes joint repairs, curb and gutter replacement, drainage improvement, and sidewalk ramp upgrades compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

When Will This Be Done?

Work is scheduled to begin in August and be completed by the middle of October.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times on M-66 using lane closures with traffic shifts or flag control. Pedestrian traffic will be maintained at all times.

Long-term Benefits

Resurfacing M-66 and completing joint repairs will increase the service life and improve the ride quality of the roadway.
