



# M-99 (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) Pavement Repairs Lansing

Late Fall 2019

## What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest about \$4.6 million to perform pavement repairs and preventive maintenance on M-99 (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) between Edgewood Boulevard/Pleasant Grove Boulevard and Victor Avenue in Lansing. Work is expected to begin after the 4th of July holiday and be finished in October.

## How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Traffic will be maintained throughout the project. One lane will be open in each direction with a center left-turn lane during daytime hours and most evenings. Certain nighttime construction activity will require closing the center left-turn lane; both through-lanes will remain open.
