- Q. On page 1 of the subject project description it is stated that
"Another component of this project is a noise analysis along the corridor. The Scope of Service is attached (Attachment B) and the consultant or subcontractor must be pre-qualified. The cost component of the noise analysis should be itemized separately."
However the prequalification classifications listed below do not include noise.

Can you clarify whether a contractor or subcontractor would have to prequalified in noise?

- A. Under **SECONDARY PREQUALIFICATION CLASSIFICATIONS:** was listed **"Conduct Technical SEE Studies P/PMS Task 2310 – Attachment B."** The consultant or subcontractor must be prequalified. See answer below for further clarification.

- Q. Concerning the secondary prequalification of Conducting Technical SEE Studies P/PMS Task 2310, is that also referred to as Technical Assistance Prequalification? We seem to be unable to locate that particular prequalification category.

- A. The secondary prequalification of **"Conduct Technical SEE Studies P/PMS Task 2310"** should have read **"Noise Assessment/Abatement, P/PMS Task 2310"** as listed on Attachment B. MDOT prequalified service vendors can be found on the MDOT website (www.michigan.gov/mdot) under **"Doing Business."**

- Q. Could an acoustical consulting firm submit a proposal for the noise abatement study independent of the road design component for this project?

- A. **No. Proposals for the noise assessment/abatement study from a MDOT prequalified firm would be included in the primary consultant's proposal.**
