Q: Do these proposals still adhere to the 20-page length limit, or are there newer guidelines that supersede the May 2013 guidelines?

A: The MDOT Consultant Vendor Selection Guidelines for Research Administration- Revised May 2013 is the most current revision of our guidelines. On page 7 of the document, it states the following: “Proposals are limited to twenty (20) pages in length, excluding the cover page, table of contents and appendices.” For your reference, that document is located at this address:

Q: The Request for Proposal documents for Requisition Numbers 1767, 1768, 1769, 1770 state that MDOT will not accept multiple submittals. Does this mean that only one proposal can be submitted for each requisition by an entity?

A: MDOT will not accept more than one (1) proposal per Principal Investigator for each Requisition Number.

Q: Can you clarify whether the report listed as a deliverable in this RFP (a report detailing best pavement marking and delineation practices...) is the final report required as a deliverable in the MDOT Guidelines or is it a report in addition to that final report?

A: The report listed as a deliverable in this RFP is the same as the final report.
