- 1.) Is MDOT anticipating an out of the box solution to fulfill the "Data Storage & Accessibility" requirements, or is MDOT anticipating compensation for the development of the tools? Or if there were a solution that existed that fulfilled the majority of the requirements, would MDOT allow for compensation for the development of the rest of the tools?

MDOT does not have a preference on "out of box" vs. custom developed solution or a composition of the two. The selected vendor will be expected to fulfill the scope requirements by providing solution(s) as a service to meet the data storage and accessibility requirements at no additional cost to the department. To balance availability of funds (TIER 1 – Up to \$150,000) and provide compensation for the "Data Storage & Accessibility" requirements, the collection will be limited as described on page 6 of the RFP with scope variance negotiated to account for the maximum number of collection locations possible with \$70,000.00.

- 2.) Would reimbursement be allowed as a pass through cost for the setup of the software if the setup were performed by the distributors of the solution?

All reimbursements need to meet MDOT's criteria for reimbursement, within the limitations of the contract value (Tier I – Up to \$150000).
