Draft 2014-2017 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

You can influence the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) planning process that identifies and funds surface transportation projects across the state.

The STIP lists projects that MDOT is committed to over the next four years using federal funding, including transit (bus), small urban and non-metropolitan road and bridge projects.

The draft STIP features information on:

- \$482 million in road improvements
- \$88 million in bridge repairs or replacements
- \$367 million in transit (bus) investments
- Funding assumptions and challenges facing Michigan
- Project-selection process

Tell MDOT what you think. Projects take time to develop and fund, so get involved now and help influence project selection.
