Dear Members of the Michigan Legislature:

Public Act 286 of 1964, Section 247.813, requires the State Transportation Commission (STC) to keep accurate records of all of its acts and proceedings and a complete account of all financial transactions of the department in accordance with the accounting laws of the state. In addition to other reports required by law, the commission shall submit to the governor and the legislature, on or before January 1 of each year, an annual report of its activities.

On December 21, 2011, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) sent you a copy of the Annual Report of the Michigan Transportation Fund (see attached). This report summarizes revenues collected, cost of administration, authorized expenditures, and the amounts distributed to each county road commission, city, and village.

STC provides copies of meeting minutes to the legislature and Governor's office on a monthly basis, and posts the agendas, minutes, and notices on the following website: http://michigan.gov/mdot/0,1607,7-151-9623_31969_31970_31974---Y,00.html. This complies with the Open Meetings Act, Public Act 267 of 1976.
