

US-12 and M-51 Interchange Reconstruction Open House No. 2 Announcement

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) has scheduled a second open house to discuss the 2023 reconstruction of the US-12 and M-51 interchange in Niles Township, Berrien County. The deteriorating condition of US-12 bridges over M-51 must be addressed. Analysis performed for this transportation study includes traffic operations, safety, pavement treatment, storm sewer inspection, environmental resource, and the Michigan Left (indirect left turn) signalized intersection has been identified as the leading alternative. Since the study began, three projects have been added amounting to \$30 million of work.

- M-51 repaying from the Michigan/Indiana state line to south of Chestnut Lane (2019).
- M-51 repaying from south of Chestnut Lane to M-60 Business Route (2023).
- US-12 Reconstruction from 3rd Street to M-51 (2023).

The Open House will be 4 - 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, February 6, 2019, at Southwestern Michigan College Niles Campus, Community Room 134, located at 33890 US-12. MDOT staff will be on-hand to collect comments and to answer questions regarding this study. There will be short presentations on study progress at 4:15 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Public input is important for identifying local priorities and key issues to address in future work. Attendees are encouraged to share experiences and observations related to the safe and efficient operation of US-12 and M-51.


