SECTION 10e(21) REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE

Section 10e(21) of Public Act 51 of 1951, as amended (Act 51), states:

After January 1, 1979, the department shall submit an annual report to the legislature detailing the service provided in the prior year for persons 65 years of age or older and persons with disabilities by fixed route service and demand actuated service. This report shall include a report of passenger usage and shall be submitted by April 1 of each year.

For Fiscal Year (FY) 2012, the total ridership was 98,266,915, which is a decrease of 1.5 percent from FY 2011. A total of 3,554 transit vehicles, of which 3,225 are lift or ramp equipped, are in service in Michigan. The percentage of lift or ramp-equipped vehicles is 91 percent.
