Public Act 59 of 2013, Section 601**

**PERFORMANCE AND ROAD CONSTRUCTION WARRANTIES
Fiscal Year (FY) 2014**

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) continues to work with the road construction industries and its many other customers to develop and enhance performance and materials and workmanship warranties for road construction projects as required by Public Act 59, Public Acts 2013.

MDOT has/will let 137 warranty projects in the Rehabilitation/Reconstruction (R&R) and Capital Preventive Maintenance (CPM) Programs for FY 2014 consisting of the following:

- 98 Projects in the CPM program. These are two- to three-year Performance and Material and Workmanship warranties
- 39 Projects in the R&R program. These are five-year Materials and Workmanship Warranties.

MDOT and the contracting industry continue to make use of the Statewide Warranty Administration Database (SWAD) to track and monitor the status of warranty projects. Furthermore, processes will be enhanced to put additional checks and balances in place to ensure that all warranted projects are properly recorded and tracked throughout their warranty periods.

MDOT continues to explore new and innovative construction and contracting methods in order to provide the highest quality integrated transportation service for economic benefit and improved quality of life for all of our customers.
