What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be repairing joints, resurfacing and reconstructing 6.4 miles of US-131 from north of M-32 to south of Boyne Falls.

When Will This Be Done?

Construction is scheduled to begin in March and be completed in October.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

This work will require lane closures under flag control. The contractor will be limited to one flag control section no longer than 1 mile at a time. Lane closures will be removed by 3 p.m. each Friday, with work suspended on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

Long-term Benefits

This project will extend the service life of the roadway, and improve safety, ride quality and convenience for motorists.
