What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be repaving 6.6 miles of US-131 between I-94 and U Avenue in Portage, Kalamazoo County. Construction includes guardrail upgrades, carpool lot resurfacing, new signs and pavement markings, fence replacement, ramp work and traffic signals.

When Will This Be Done?

Construction is scheduled to start in March and be completed in August.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

One lane of US-131 will be open in each direction. The US-131 ramps at Centre Street will be closed and detoured for up to 30 days. The public will be notified when the closures are scheduled.

Long-term Benefits

The new pavement on US-131 and the ramps will improve safety and serve motorists for many years to come.
