



VETERAN INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Veteran employment opportunities with the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) are made possible through funding provided by the Federal Highway Administration. This program is intended to meet the employment needs of honorably discharged veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces as they transition into the civilian workforce. MDOT is partnering with nationwide service-related organizations to fill needed positions for our veterans.

OPPORTUNITIES TO WORK • LEARN • EARN

Placement depends upon the veteran's knowledge, skills and abilities. MDOT offers a variety of employment opportunities, such as aeronautics, engineering, finance, maintenance, planning, and administrative support.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- ★ Veterans can compete for MDOT jobs or develop skills needed for outside employment.
- ★ Veterans will be compensated at an hourly rate determined by the skill set needed for the position.
- ★ Veterans will be provided proper training, mentorship and solid leadership during their internship.
- ★ Veterans will be provided reasonable accommodations and continued training opportunities.
- ★ Veterans will have coaching for resume writing and interview skills.

ELIGIBILITY

All honorably discharged veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces are eligible.
