SUBJECT: Request for Waiver of Commission Approval of Contract

The projects and descriptions documented in Exhibit A, attached, require State Transportation Commission approval prior to the contracts being awarded. The approximate five week delay resulting if Commission approval were deferred to the May 22, 2014, Commission meeting could jeopardize the timeliness of the award of the contracts, as well as the performance of the project work necessary.

The projects and descriptions documented in Exhibit A-1, attached, are scheduled to be let by the Michigan Department of Transportation on May 2 and May 7, 2014. These projects require pre-approval as the engineers' estimates are over \$500,000. The approximate five week delay resulting if Commission approval were deferred to the May 22, 2014, Commission meeting would delay the transmittal of the contract documents to the low bidders, and could jeopardize the construction schedules for these projects.

The projects and descriptions documented in Exhibit A-2, attached, were let by the Michigan Department of Transportation on April 4, 2014. These projects required pre-approval as the engineer's estimate was over \$500,000, however the low bids received were more than 10% over the engineer's estimate and therefore require approval by the State Transportation Commission. The approximate five week delay resulting if Commission approval were deferred to the May 22, 2014, Commission meeting would delay the transmittal of the contract documents to the low bidders, and could jeopardize the construction schedules for these projects.


Commission Resolution 79-3, as amended, provides in footnote F:

Amendatory Contract (2012-0562/A3) between MDOT and Indian Trails, Inc., will increase the contract amount by \$580,000, including \$290,000 in federal funds and \$290,000 in state funds, and will extend the contract term by one year to provide for an additional year of the intercity bus service. The original contract provides Federal Section 5311(f) Intercity Bus Program funds and state funds for intercity bus operating service in Michigan. The revised contract term will be August 1, 2012, through July 31, 2015. The revised contract amount will be \$6,152,068. Source of Funds: Federal Transit Administration Funds - \$3,076,034; FY 2010, FY 2011, FY 2012, FY 2013, and FY 2014 Sate Restricted Comprehensive Transportation Funds - \$3,076,034.

19. *RAIL – Increase Maximum Amount
Amendatory Contract (2012-0292/A1) between MDOT and Quandel Consultants, LLC, will increase the maximum contract amount by \$75,000 in Federal Transit Administration funds to provide for the performance of additional as-needed services. The original contract provides for as-needed engineering and project management services to be performed to support MDOT projects along the Chicago-Detroit/Pontiac High Speed Rail Corridor. The services may include tasks related to management, planning, and design activities to support the improvement and implementation of accelerated rail services in Michigan and other engineering and project management services as they may arise. The contract term remains unchanged, May 7, 2012, through September 15, 2015. The revised maximum contract amount will be \$1,400,000. Source of Funds: FY 2011 State Restricted Comprehensive Transportation Funds - \$1,325,000; Federal Transit Administration Funds - \$75,000.
20. *RAIL - Freight Economic Development Program
Contract (2014-0230) between MDOT and Zilwaukee Properties, Inc., will provide financial assistance in the form of a loan for the rehabilitation and extension of existing rail spurs at Sargent Docks and Terminal in Zilwaukee, Michigan, to accommodate unit trains. This project will increase the storage capacity at the facility, allowing better pricing on fertilizer, salt, and other materials. This project will also help the company to expand its operations, creating at least five new positions. The contract will be in effect from the date of award until the last obligation between the parties has been fulfilled, until the contract is terminated, or until the loan has been fully repaid. The estimated project cost is \$906,100. MDOT will loan Zilwaukee Properties, Inc., 50 percent of the project cost, up to a maximum amount of \$453,050. Provisions included in the contract permit the loan to be forgiven incrementally over a five-year period if Zilwaukee Properties, Inc., ships a minimum of 542 additional carloads of freight to/from the facility annually, over and above the existing 210 carloads currently shipped. Source of Funds: FY 2014 State Restricted Comprehensive Transportation Funds - \$453,050; Zilwaukee Properties, Inc., Funds - \$453,050.
21. *RAIL - Freight Economic Development Program
Contract (2014-0231) between MDOT and Marengo Enterprise, LLC, will provide financial assistance in the form of a grant for the rehabilitation of an existing rail spur at the company's new facility in Flint, Michigan. This project will help the company to mill spiral-weld steel pipe for the manufacturing of water pipe, creating at least 50 new positions. The contract will be in effect from the date of award until the last obligation between the parties has been fulfilled, until the contract is terminated, or until the appropriate grant funds have been dispersed. The estimated project cost is \$133,302.40. MDOT will reimburse Marengo Enterprise, LLC, for 50 percent of the project cost, up to a maximum amount of \$66,651.20. The contract provides for actual reimbursement to be calculated based on the number of carloads of freight shipped to and from the facility annually over a five-year reporting period. Marengo Enterprise, LLC, commits to shipping and/or receiving 125 carloads of freight annually. Source of Funds: FY 2014 State Restricted Comprehensive Transportation Funds - \$66,651.20; Marengo Enterprise, LLC, Funds - \$66,651.20.

Upon receipt of your approval, the contracts and agreements will be processed for award. Subject to the exercise of the discretion in the processing, I approve the contracts described in this agenda and authorize the award by the responsible management staff of MDOT to the extent authorized by and in accordance with the December 14, 1983, resolution of the State Transportation Commission and the Director's delegation memorandum of October 7, 2013.
