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 FY2002-FY2012 Quality Improvement and Encounter Data

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Definitions: **Mental Illness:** An individual is determined to have mental illness if he/she has a DSM-IV diagnosis of mental illness, excluding mental retardation, developmental disability or substance abuse disorder.

**Developmental Disability:** An individual is determined to have a developmental disability if he/she meets the 1996 Mental Health Code Definition of Developmental Disability, regardless of the types of services that he/she receives.

**Dual Diagnosis:** Beginning FY2001, CMHSPs and PIHPs were given the option to designate an individual as having a 'dual diagnosis' if he/she met the standards for both mental illness as well as developmental disability.

**Children** are those consumers who are 18 years of age or younger during the fiscal year of reporting.

Note: **Consumers who were only reported to have a substance use disorder are excluded from the counts above. Additionally, for FY 2011 those reported as "Assessment Only" have been excluded from this report.**
