SENIOR CITIZENS ORGANIZATION QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

The following documentation shall be submitted as part of the qualification process:

<u>Senior Citizens Organizations</u> can qualify for licensing and shall submit the following information in the name of the organization prior to being approved to conduct a millionaire party event.

- 1. A detailed letter on organization letterhead, signed and dated by the principal officer of the organization, specifying:
 - a. The main source(s) of funds received, the main use(s) of funds expended, and the specific purpose of the organization.
 - b. Verification the organization contains at least 15 members that are 60 years of age or older.
- 2. A signed and dated copy of the organization's current bylaws or constitution, including membership criteria
- 3. A complete copy of the organization's articles of incorporation that have been filed with the Corporations and Securities Bureau, if the organization is incorporated
- 4. A provision in the bylaws, constitution, or articles of incorporation that indicates the organization exists for the mutual support and advancement of the causes of elderly or retired persons
- 5. A provision in the bylaws, constitution, or articles of incorporation that indicates all assets, real property, and personal property will revert to the local government or another nonprofit organization should the organization dissolve
- 6. A copy of the letter from the IRS stating the organization is exempt from federal tax under IRS code 501(c). (If the organization is not exempt under 501(c), submit a copy of one bank statement per year for the previous five years).
- 7. A copy of the organization's annual financial statements including income statement and balance sheet information for the previous three years
- 8. A copy of the organization's annual tax returns for the previous three years. (e.g. 990, 990-EZ, or 990-N e-Postcard)
- 9. A copy of the organization's bank statements for the previous twelve months
- 10. A copy of the organization's check register for the previous twelve months
- 11. A copy of the organization's credit card and procurement card statements for the previous twelve months

Act 382 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, defines a senior citizen organization as "an organization within this state that is organized not for pecuniary profit, that consists of at least 15 members who are 60 years of age or older, and that exists for their mutual support and for the advancement of the causes of elderly or retired persons."
